- when will you be personally liable?








### What type of liability?

- not civil: \$
- criminal fines
  - imprisonment




### Are you already personally liable?:



- trading
- as individual?

#### Personally liable when the company causes death:


S.56 Health & Safety in Employment Act 1992





#### s56 HSE:

- officers
- directors
- agents





#### **HSE: Penalties:**

- \$500,000 or 2 years for "knowing" serious harm offences
- breach of duties 'all practicable steps' \$250,000



### Personal liability for corporate killing:

- Crimes Act 1961 offences
  - conspiracy
- more difficult
- Le Race: R v Anderson



### Personal liability and chain of responsibility legislation

- S.79k Land Transport Amendment Bill
- directors:
  - express or implied authority
  - failed to take all reasonable steps
  - way of the future?
