Heavy vehicle rule reform

- Consulting on a range of rule changes affecting heavy vehicles, including potential changes to permitting.
- Phase 1 (consultation currently open)
 - permit requirements for 50MAX vehicles (Land Transport Rule: Vehicle Dimensions and Mass 2016).
- Phase 2 (consultation will open early 2026)
 - permit requirements for rental service licence holders, over dimension divisible loads, and vehicle recovery licence holders
- VDAM changes, work underway through 2027.









Summary of Applications (Since July 2025)




